

Recycling bins will be collected fortnightly on the same day as your normal garbage collection.

How to place your bins for collection

Correct Bin Placement



Follow these guidelines to help make collection easy and efficient

- All bins must be placed in front of your property either on the kerb or near the roadway.
- On recycling days place bins at least one metre apart and clear of any cars, trees or other obstacles.

- Place bin with wheels facing away from the road, no further than one metre from the kerb or road's edge.
- Bins must be placed out by the evening prior to your collection day.
- Your bin lid should close completely and nothing should protrude out of the top

Your participation in the recycling service will result in saved landfill space, maximum recovery of resources and reduction in greenhouse gas emissions.

Items which can be recycled are:

- Newspapers, magazines, office paper, cardboard and junk mail
- All glass bottles and jars - these need to be rinsed and no lids
- Steel and aluminium cans and empty aerosols
- All plastic bottles and containers marked 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 & 7 - no lids
- Juice and milk cartons

Items which can not be recycled are:


- Garden waste
- Ceramics, ovenware or light bulbs
- Plastic bags
