Swim School Policies

Family Discounts:

Family Discounts only apply when FULL PAYMENT is made for ALL children at the one time. Payment is required at time of enrolment.

Discount: 5% for second child, 10% for third and more children.

Make-ups:

Make-ups can only be issued when an absence has been notified at least **2 hours prior** to the lesson. Make-ups can not be guaranteed and only work if absences are notified. Make-ups can not be carried over to the next term or transferred to credit.

Medical Policy:

If a child is enrolled in the Splash Swim School and has a medical

condition, the parent must list the type of condition in the enrolment details. (this is kept confidential)

Credits:

Credits are only issued in extenuating circumstances or for extended periods of **notified** absences in conjunction with a doctor's certificate.

Credits will not be issued for a single missed lesson during the term. Make-ups are for this purpose.

Refunds:

No refunds will be given for classes missed during the term.

Management will use its discretion in exceptional circumstances.

Enrolments/Re-enrolments:

Enrolments will not be taken if money is outstanding on a profile

"What is Active Supervision at Public Pools?

Be Prepared: Ensure you have everything you need before getting into the water, such as towels and dry clothes

Be Close: Always be within arm's reach of your child

All of Your Attention: Focus all of your attention on your child and get into the pool and talk and play with them

All of the Time: You should never leave your child alone in the water, nor should they be left in the care of an older child or with the assumption that your responsibility diminishes due to the presence of lifeguards"

Hi All and welcome to Term 4 2022!

Pools are great fun but they can also be dangerous places for children, regardless of their swimming ability or how often they have been to our pool, as they can get easily distracted or get into situations they have difficulty getting out of. While Pool staff provide an extra layer of safety, it is YOUR responsibility to make sure that you are **constantly** watching any child 10 years or under in your care and making sure they remain safe With children aged 5 years or less you must be within 1 arms length at all times, this means getting in the pool with them ready to pick them up and place them on their feet or place a hand under them to reassure them if they start to panic. Please do not be offended if our staff speak to you if they feel that you are too far away or distracted, on your phone or talking, and not supervising your child. We all want the same thing for all children that visit, a fun and SAFE time.

Term 4 is a great time to get back in the pool for lessons and fun with the weather warming up but keep in mind it is also a very busy time of year so get in early to book Swimming lessons, if you are currently paying per Term I encourage you to enquire about our perpetual direct debit payment system, not only will you not have to come up with entire term's swimming lesson payment at one time but it will also secure your spot for following Term.

Finally we hope everyone has a fabulous Term 4 at our wonderful facility but please staff safe and vigilant around the water:)
