

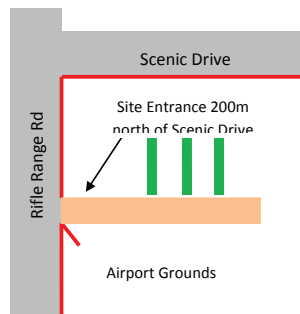
Prickly Pear Disposal
