The exhibition encourages the creation and purchase of locally made art and artisan objects as gifts for family and friends during the festive season. We aim to foster local creativity and appreciation of locally sourced and produced art. Established, experienced and amateur artists and craftspeople are encouraged to apply.

CONDITIONS

1. Entry is open to all artists currently residing in the Riverina area.
2. Up to five (5) artworks may be entered per artist.
3. Size of each item must not exceed 60 x 60 x 60cm.
4. Artwork must be clearly labelled with artist name, phone number and title of work and sale price if applicable.
5. Canvases and framed works must arrive ready to hang with D-rings on the back. If you require clarification please contact gallery staff.
6. Entry form, entry fee (\$5 per entry) and artwork must be delivered no later than Sunday 30th November 2018.
7. We encourage artworks that are for sale. Final sale price of artwork must include 30% commission. Artists must be aware of their GST obligations (if any) prior to determining their sale price and completing the submission form.
8. Artists agree to their entry being reproduced by print and electronic media in advertising and for promotion of the exhibition and when promoting the Gallery. Artists will be acknowledged appropriately if their work is used.
9. Artwork must have been created within 24 months prior to 30th November, must be an original work created by the named artist and must not have been previously exhibited at Griffith Regional Art Gallery.
10. The Gallery will be closed from 22nd December 2018 to Monday 14th January 2019. Artworks can be collected from 14th January and must be collected by 1st February 2019. If you are unable to collect artworks during this time please notify the Gallery to make an alternative arrangement.
11. Works created by more than one person maybe entered. Please make this clear on the entry form.
12. The Gallery retains the right to not exhibit all entries and the exhibition is by selection. The Gallery's decision regarding the selection of works is final.
13. By submitting works to Objects of Desire you agree to the above conditions.
