COMMERCIAL PRICKLY PEAR

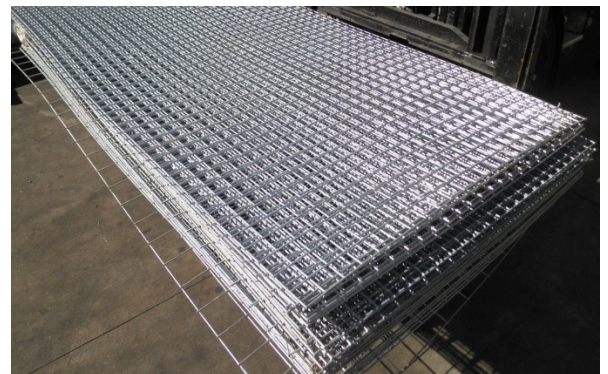
Landholders interested in growing Prickly pear in the Griffith Council will be required to enter into an agreement and abide by conditions set out by the Griffith City Council.

Requirements:

1. Prickly pear must be enclosed within a **“bird-proof enclosure”**, to avoid seed transportation to other locations.
2. All fruit must be removed each growing season and excess fruit disposed of in an appropriate manner, i.e. **“bag excess fruit, incinerate, or bury fruit to a depth of 2 metres”**.
3. Plants must be **“trimmed and maintained in enclosed area”**, any plant material removed should be disposed of in an appropriate manner.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH REQUIREMENTS WILL VOID AGREEMENT AND ALL PRICKLY PEAR WILL HAVE TO BE REMOVED
