Description	On 21 August 2015 the Developer lodged Development Application DA 158/2015 for the construction and use of a rural supplies business including a fertiliser shed on Lot 528 DP 751709 known as 11514 Kidman Way, Griffith. On 11 May 2018 the Land and Environment Court made orders to grant consent to DA 158/2015 subject to conditions.
