PRICKLY PEAR & SEEDS

Harvesting all the fruit will greatly reduce the available fruit for birds to transport to new locations, and establish new infestations





The Images above: show fruit that have been eaten by birds and transported and deposited to new locations, this can be a few hundred metres away or kilometres away; and to all points of the compass; Seeds fertilised and ready to germinate

New seedlings: can be found under trees, power lines on roadside reserves, supply/drainage canals, **Most** go unnoticed until they start to dominate in height - against native grasses and other vegetation

These single plant infestations can be easily removed; upto a metre in height and disposed of completely – We only need to make the effort!
