Message from the Manager

Hi everyone

As we move into what we hope to be the warmer months of the year, it is even more important that our kids are taught how to swim. In this regard it is fantastic to see how many have enrolled in Splash Swim School for this Term.

With more enrolments and also the increased patronage in the Centre, I would like to remind everyone of their responsibilities with regard to supervising their children. Whilst our Life Guards do a fantastic job, I need our parents to keep an eye on their kids as well.

The Keep Watch campaign and GRALC's entry conditions advise;-

- 0-5 year olds and Non Swimmers are to be within arms reach at all times in and around water
- 6-10 Year olds and Weak Swimmers are to be kept under constant supervision and you need to be prepared to get wet or enter the water
- 11-14 Year Olds it is recommend that you physically check up on them on a regular basis.

We ask that whilst the kids are in and around the water that you minimise or refrain from using your mobile phones—it only takes a second for a kid to go under water.

Help US Help YOU to keep your kids safe.
