Notice of Temporary Road Closure

Notice is hereby given under the Roads Act 1993, Section 122 that Construction is currently continuing on Stage 6B of the Griffith Southern Industrial Link (GSIL), funded under the Roads to Recovery and Restart NSW Fixing Country Roads Programs.
