IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR CONSTRUCTION DAY SUNDAY 7 OCTOBER & DISMANTLE DAY SUNDAY 21 OCTOBER

- Rubber Bands, Location maps & Maintenance Roster will be ready for collection from the Griffith Visitor Information Centre from Wednesday 26 September 2018.
- Make sure you have removed all the old rubber bands from the previous year, prior to construction day. Please return any bags of unused rubber bands to the Visitor Information Centre as they are very valuable and expensive rubber bands.
- All volunteers are required to report to their area inductor (wearing a safety vest) on construction day upon entering the sculpture site. Children must be supervised at all times. Fully enclosed footwear must be worn whilst onsite. Anyone non-compliant will be turned away.
- Once you have dropped off your sculpture please remove your vehicle from Banna Avenue to avoid vehicle congestion.
- Please be patient whilst waiting for the forklifts to drop bins of oranges on construction day off and empty bins on dismantle day to your area. The volunteer forklift drivers will make sure bins are distributed evenly to all sculptures in due course.
- For safety reasons, please notify your inductor of any steel pegs installed on your sculpture on construction day. Please also make sure your peg count is checked off with a Council representative on dismantle day.
- You are expected to provide enough volunteers to secure the oranges onto your sculpture on construction day as well taking them off on the 21st October. If you bring a few buckets along this will also help in carting oranges from the big orange bins to and from your sculpture. You will also need to provide your own ladder if required. If your frame is higher than 2m, you will require a safe system of construction to prevent falls from height. This may include the use of work platforms minimum width 450mm or scaffolding.

2018 NEW SCULPTURE REGULATIONS:

- 90% of your sculpture MUST be citrus and your sculpture must be 3D.
- We are looking for creative sculptures think of something unique. Your sculpture doesn't have to symbolize your organization completely. What would visitors want to take a selfie with to share with their friends and family?
- All Applications for 2018 must be submitted to Karly Sivewright Events Coordinator at Griffith City Council for approval prior to 1 August 2018. You will be notified prior to 14 August 2018 if your sculpture has been approved.
- Your structure must be engineered to be stable, withstand climatic elements and safe from trip hazards. No boring of holes into the lawn will be permitted. Pegs are to be secured into the lawn at a maximum of 300mm deep. Frames to be made from square mesh (NOT chook wire).
- Signage identifying your business/ organisation will be provided. There will be no additional/ commercial signage allowed.
- The Citrus Sculptures are a fun community celebration of creativity and we want to ensure our community is safe. An information night will be held over 2 nights: (dates TBC) to go over all requirements.
