Notice is hereby given under the Roads Act 1993, Section 122 for the temporary closing of the following road(s):

Jones Road between Lakes Road and Boorga Road will be closed to through traffic from 7am on Saturday 19 January 2018 until 5pm Sunday 21 January 2018 for repairs to the road surface on Jones Road between the two lakes. Alternative route will be clearly sign posted. B Double detour is via Kookora Street, Kooringal Avenue, Palla Street and Wyangan Avenue/Boorga Road. Road Train detour is via Kookora Street, Willandra Avenue, Kidman Way, North Kooba Settlers Road/Wilga Road, Griffith City Council offices and works depot will be Irrigation Way and Whitton Stock Route.

Queen's Baton Relay - Notice of Temporary Road

The Queen's Baton Relay will take place on 28 January 2018 at approximately 4:30pm from the Griffith Exies Sports Club making its way to the Burley Griffin Community Gardens via Speirs Street, Wakaden Street, Blumer Avenue, Banna Avenue, Kookora Street, Murrumbidgee Avenue and Coolah Street. The Baton will arrive in the Burley Griffin Community Gardens at 5:30pm for an end of day community celebration. Traffic management and road closures will be in place along the route to ensure a safe procession of the relay convoy. Road closures will be in place in the following locations;

- Banna Avenue Crossing Street to Kookora Street
