Policy Objective

1. To regulate door-knock appeals so as to minimise disturbance to the privacy and nuisance caused to residents.
2. To regulate public collections so as to safe guard against fraud and public nuisances and to promote public safety.
3. To safe guard against fraud and to minimise nuisance and embarrassment to shoppers.

Policy Statement

1. Door-knock Appeals

Door-knock appeals shall require the written approval of Council and will be permitted only by charities with local committees. The appeal is not to commence before 9.00 am.

2. Public Collections

No person or organisation shall solicit or collect gifts of money or of subscriptions for any purpose in any public place without obtaining the prior approval of the Council. The collection of money from motorists on the carriageway of roads is prohibited.
