Customer needs to obtain permission from neighbouring properties, in writing. Any property that comes within 225 metres of a town water supply becomes eligible for a town water access charge, regardless of whether they connect to the town water supply or not as per Local Government Act 1993 Section 552 and Council Policy WS-CP-202.

If approved, the absolute minimum charge, not including any water main construction works, will be \$14,110 plus S94 Water Allocation fees. **Please Note: This amount is an estimate only for information purposes and fees are subject to change.**

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INFORMATION ON WATER MAIN EXTENSION

When an applicant wishes to have Council's reticulated water services extended to their property, firstly the applicant must obtain written approval from all other landowners within 225 metres of the proposed mains extension that become eligible for paying water access charges (water rates). If any landowners object to this proposed main extension then the extension cannot go ahead. If all landowners agree then the proposed main extension can be investigated for feasibility.

Council charges include one off charges such as investigation fees, contribution fees (explained below), property connection and connection to existing infrastructure charges.

Annual charges will include access, usage and depending on the land usage, backflow prevention device testing.

Please contact Griffith City Council for more information relating to non-residential type connections.

Most water main construction costs are borne by the applicant (and other beneficiaries if desired). Minimum water main pipe size is 100mm (this is the pipe that your proposed property water service would connect to).

Construction costs can vary greatly according to difficulty, however, as a guide minimum cost is \$150/metre, (excluding rock, limited space, road/rail crossings, relocation of existing services etc)

Contribution Fees

Section 64 Developer Contribution Fees – to contribute to the required water infrastructure a levy needs to be paid for an increase in demand on that infrastructure.

Water Allocations Contribution Fees – for Rural Residential with raw water extensions Griffith City Council requires a bulk water transfer of minimum 0.4 ML of high security water (with no raw water then a minimum of 1.5ML) to Council's water allocation, if permitted by Murrumbidgee Irrigation.

Council will need to sign the Permanent Internal Transfer of Entitlement Form from Murrumbidgee Irrigation or you can pay a cash contribution (which is the market rate + 20% of the total dollar value, plus an administration fee of \$155.00 (current pricing is approximately \$5,250/ML subject to variation).
