#### HOW TO ENTER:

- Drop off your completed entry form and artwork/s to Griffith Regional Art Gallery by 5pm Friday 18 August.
- Entry fee of \$5 per artwork must be paid at the time of delivery.
- All work must be presented ready to be hung.

#### CHECK LIST

- ☐ Canvases and framed works are ready to hang with D-rings on the back.
- ☐ I have carefully read and completed all components of the entry form, including the terms and conditions.
- ☐ I am aware of the time and date to deliver my artwork and \$5 entry fee (per entry).

### CONDITIONS

- \*Entry is open to all artists aged 15+ currently living or working in the Griffith, Leeton, Murrumbidgee, Hay, Carathool or Narranderra LGAs.
- Up to two (2) artworks may be entered per artist.
- Artwork must be clearly labelled on the back with artist's name, phone number and title of work, and price if applicable.
- Canvases and framed works must arrive ready to hang with D-rings on the back. If you required clarification please contact gallery staff.
- If artwork is not on a canvas or frame e.g. 3D works and sculptures, please contact the Gallery staff to discuss display requirements.
- Entry form, entry fee (\$5 per entry) and artwork must be delivered no later than Friday 18 August 2023 (please note the Gallery is open from 10am - 5pm Wednesday to Friday and 11am - 2pm Saturday and Sunday).
- Artworks may be for sale. Final sale price of artwork must include 30% commission. Artists must be aware of their GST obligations (if any) prior to determining their sale price and completing this submission form.
- Artists agree to their entry being reproduced by print and electronic media in advertising and promotion of the exhibition and promoting the Gallery. Artists will be acknowledged appropriately if their work is selected for this type of promotion. Reproduction will not be used directly for any financial gain.
- Artwork must have been created within 18 months prior to Friday 18 August 2023, must be original works created by the artist.
- At the close of exhibition artwork will be available for collection from Griffith Regional Art Gallery from Wednesday 27th September until Saturday 1st October 2023. If you are unable to collect artworks during this time please notify the Gallery to arrange an alternate suitable time for collection. Artworks not collected will be disposed of two weeks after the exhibition's closing date. Artworks will not be available for collection prior to Wednesday 27th September.
- Collaborative works maybe entered (more than one person has contributed to the creation of the work). Please make this clear on the entry form.
- Due to curatorial constraints and discretion all artworks submitted may not be included in the exhibition. Gallery staff reserve the right to omit submitted works from the exhibition.
